2008 TOURNAMENT RULES

Rules stated here-in and those of the U.S.B.C. will govern all participants of the tournament. The Tournament Director will have the right to accept or reject any entry and decide all questions or disputes arising in the tournament.

All decisions by the Tournament Director will be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.

1. In order to participate in this tournament bowlers must be U.S.B.C. sanctioned. Team captains must present sanction cards for each team member at the time of check-in. Five person teams may consist of any combination of male and female bowlers. PBA exempt touring players will not be eligible.
2. Bowlers may compete in the tournament as many times as they wish. A team consisting of the same five members may not cash more than once in the main prize fund. In order for a team to be considered a new team it must replace two members.
3. The tournament will use bowler's highest sanctioned average from the 2006-2007 season. If the bowler does not have an average from 2006-2007 season then their highest sanctioned average from the 2005-2006 season will be used. Those bowlers that do not have a sanctioned in average for either of the past two seasons will use their highest current average providing it is a minimum of 42 games. Summer averages, sport condition and PBA averages will not be recognized. All bowlers who do not have a sanctioned average since the 2005-2006 season will enter at 220.
4. Bowlers entering the tournament with a current average for 21 games or more that is 10 or more pins higher than their yearbook average must use that current average. Failure to use a proper average may result in disqualification if the bowler uses an average that is lower than his/her actual average. It is each individual bowler's responsibility to verify their average as correct. Bowlers have 30 days from the date they bowl to report a change in average.
5. Handicap for this tournament will be 80% from 1100. Teams with an average over 1100 will subtract 80% of the difference between their team average and 1100.
6. Team captains must check their team in at least 45 minutes prior to the squads start time. Captains may request to be paired with another team. Captains will draw for lane assignments. Teams will move pairs after each game. In the case of an odd number of teams, the team bowling on a pair unopposed must allow the anchor bowler to finish his frame before the lead-off bowler may begin the next frame.
7. The Tournament Director reserves the right to re-rate or reject any entrant prior to bowling. If the entrant does not accept the re-rated average he/she will be refunded their entry fee if it in fact had already been paid. Bowlers who have been re-rated previously must report that to the tournament director no less than 30 minutes prior to their scheduled squad time.
8. It is each entrant's responsibility to comply with Rules 319-e and 319-d as stated in the U.S.B.C. General Playing Rules. Bowlers failing to comply with rules 319-e and 319-d may be disqualified from all handicap prizes as well as his/her team.
9. Members of teams that qualify to receive prize money will be required to fill out the proper affidavits and/or U.S.B.C. Rule 319-e forms before being awarded any prize money. The winning team may be photographed.
10. Any entrant found in violation of U.S.B.C. rules where the U.S.B.C. holds that your winnings in this tournament be forfeited and paid to the team next in line, hereby agrees that there shall be no liability on the part of the Zubor Buick Team Tournament or its officers to you as an entrant in complying with such holding of the U.S.B.C.

11. If a lane breaks down for a period of ten minutes or more the Tournament Director reserves the right to move the teams on that pair to a different pair.
12. Totals transcribed from the automatic scorers onto an official Zubor Buick scoresheet will be recognized as official. Bowlers will verify that the score has been transcribed as correct after each game. If during the course of play the automatic scorer fails to keep score correctly the Tournament Director must be notified prior to an adjustment of the score. Entrants may not make score corrections on their own.
13. Any teams qualifying for prize money that have paid by check will not receive prize money until their check has cleared the bank.
14. In the event of war, fire, an act of God or any other causes beyond the control of the Tournament Director make it impossible to complete the tournament in its entirety, the Zubor Buick Team Tournament and its officers will not be liable for the entire prize fund and will have no further liability to its entrants.

Prize fees will be returned 100%. First place is \$20,000 GUARANTEED. At least 1 in 10 teams will cash. In the case of ties prize money will be split.



BAKER TEAM GAME - Your team will accumulate a 3 game Baker Team score. Beginning with the first game and continuing for all three games your team will have a Baker Team score calculated in the following manner:

Each bowler will contribute two frames from each game toward the team Baker Game score. The Baker Game team score will be comprised of the leadoff bowler's 1st and 6th frames, the second bowler's 2nd and 7th frames, the third bowler's 3rd and 8th frames, the fourth bowler's 4th and 9th frames and the anchor bowler's 5th and 10th frames. An overall score for each game will be calculated and the three game total will represent your team's Baker Team Game score.

HANDICAP TEAM GAME - The highest team game score with handicap from your team's 3 game set.

TEAM IMPERFECTA - Each bowler's highest and lowest game scores with handicap will be added together and a team total will be calculated.

CRUNCH TIME - This jackpot is based on your team's performance in the 9th and 10th frames from the first two games. If a bowler strikes in the 9th frame he/she is eligible to win crunch points for his/her team. Bowler's will earn 2 pts. for throwing a double, 5 points if they throw three in a row and 6 points if they throw the last four strikes. Teams with less than a 1050 team average will receive 4 handicap points. Teams with less than a 1000 team average will receive 6 handicap points. Maximum score in this pot before handicap is 60 pts.
